

INTRODUCTION TO SILVERWAYS

Silverways is located in Highcliffe, Dorset and is sandwiched between the stunning Jurassic coastline and New Forest National Park. Silverways was opened in 1985 and continues to offer residential and respite care to all of those who require it. Over the last two years the home has benefitted from a nearly two million pound refurbishment which included all of the public areas, bedrooms and external space.

We believe that care and support are most effective when delivered in partnership with family and friends and therefore we always strive hard to include you in important decision making and daily routines.

Silverways Nursing Home is owned by Christchurch Housing Society, an organisation with charitable status which was founded in 1946 and since then has been providing accommodation and care for older people for over 75 years. The Society is run by unpaid trustees and any surpluses we generate are invested back into the community, thus also enabling us to keep our fees down, as well as ensuring that we have always more than adequate staffing.

As a charitable organisation we are not driven by profit which means we can employ a team of approximately 100 who look after a maximum of 61 residents, this staff to resident ratio is above average therefore allowing the time to carry out duties with care and dedication.

We also have Registered General
Nurses on duty 24 hours a day.
Unusually for the care sector many of
our team members have been with
us for over ten years, so you can be
assured that your loved one will not
have to have their care plan
repeatedly explained to new team
members on a regular basis. Staff also
get to know the residents as they
are assigned to the same area of the
home on every shift, thus allowing
them to form a trusting relationship.

The schedule of activities changes weekly and often reflects current affairs and seasonal themes such as The Olympics, Wimbledon, Christmas and Easter.*



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
